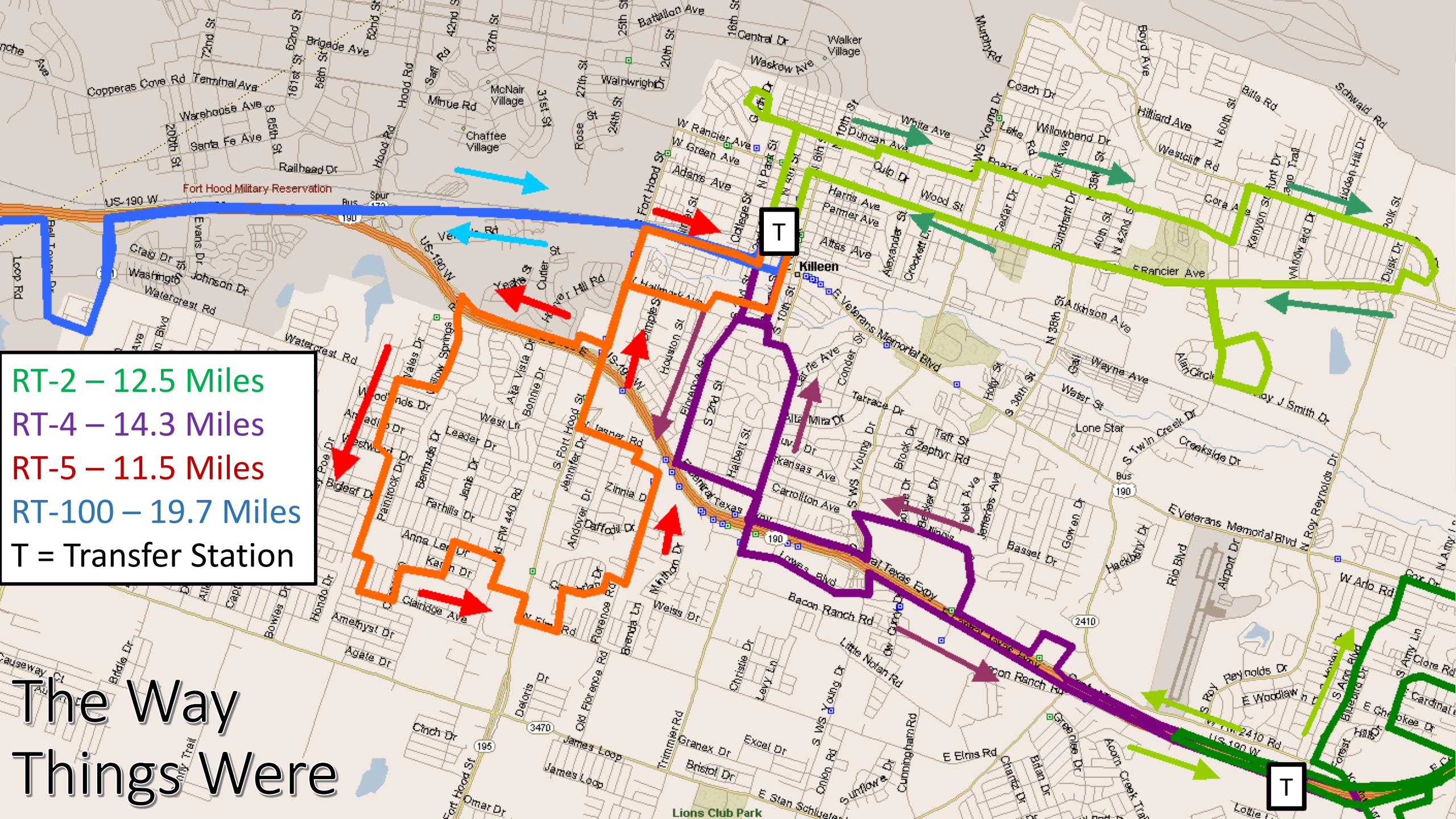

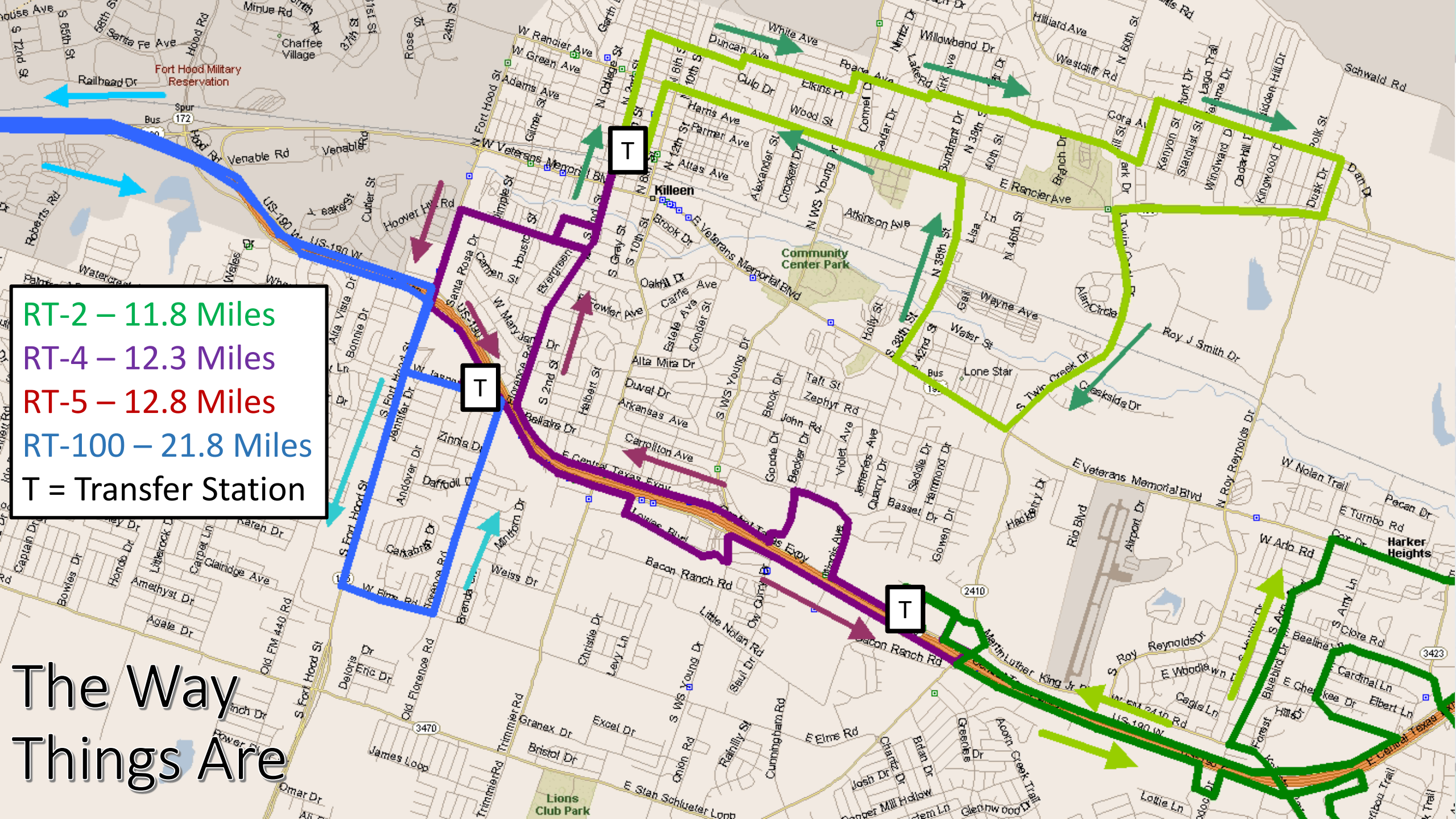
A public hearing for consideration of public comment regarding the reinstatement of fixed-route number 5, the realignment of fixed-route number 100, and a new Flex Route operating in Killeen will be held at 6:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Wednesday, December 15, 2021, in the Killeen Civic and Conference Center located at 3601 South WS Young Drive in Killeen, Texas. ADA Complimentary Paratransit Service will also be added as part of Routes 5 and 100. 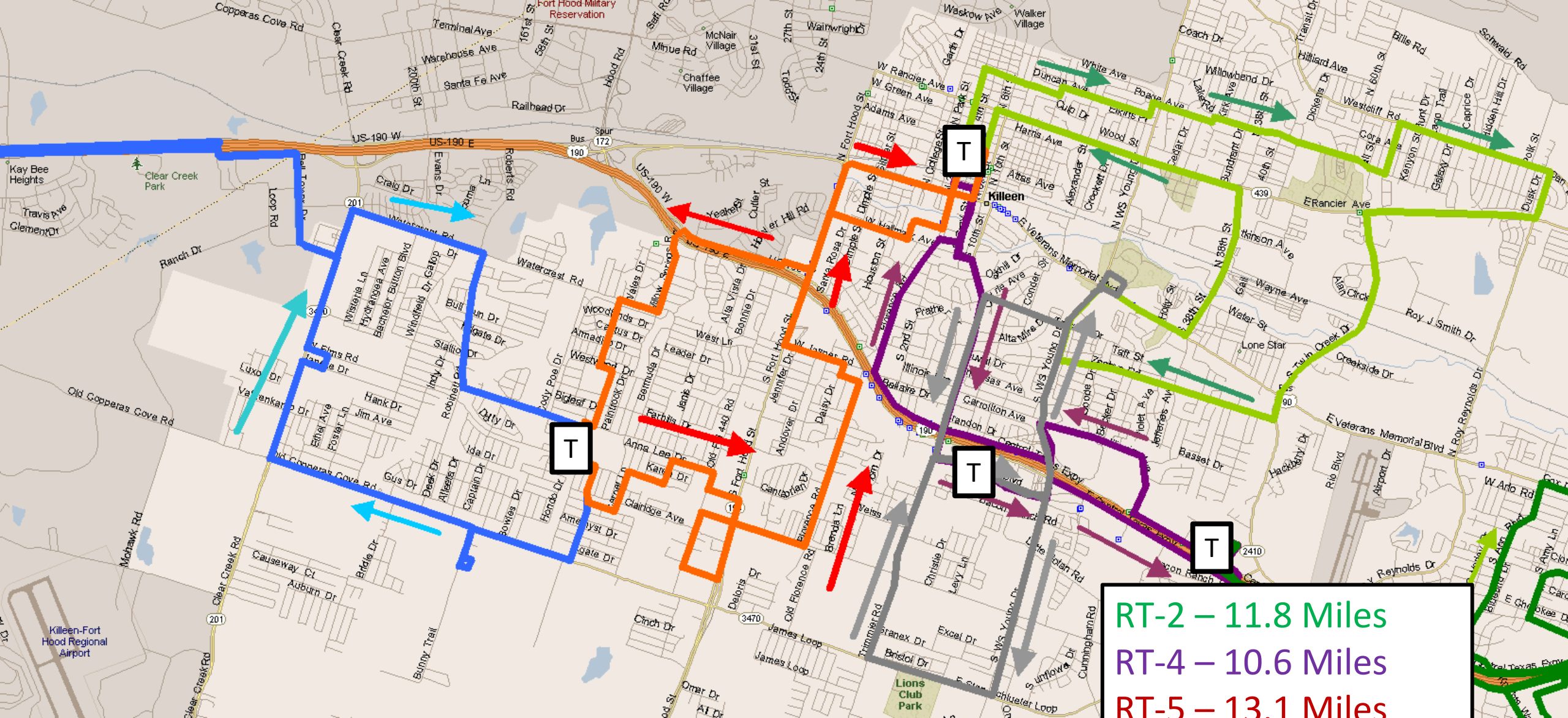
RT-2 – 12.5 Miles

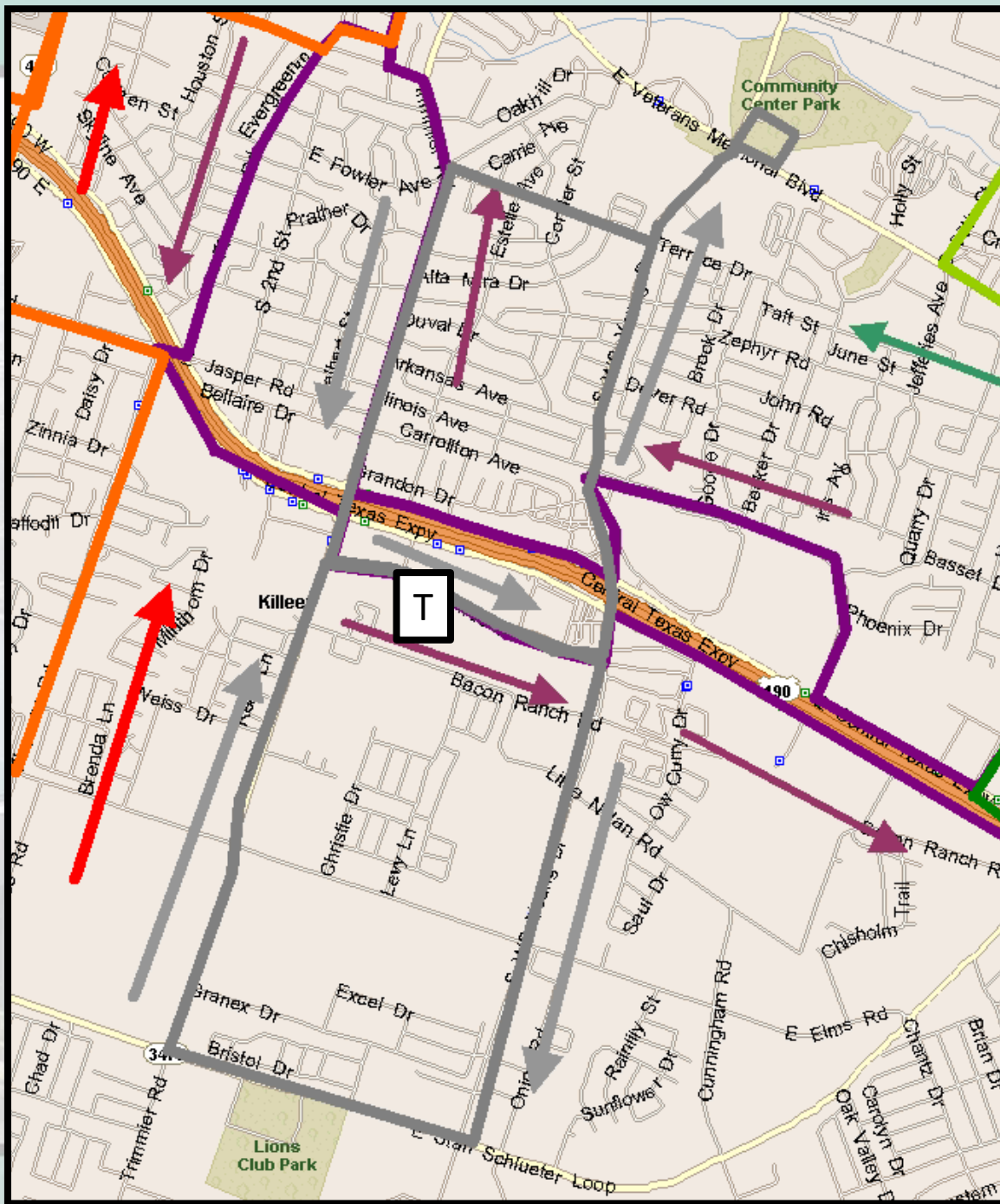

Flex Route – A NEW ARROW IN OUR QUIVER

- Hybrid Route – The scheduling of a fixed-route with the flexibility of Special Transit Service. Adds a third service to our operations (FRS, STS, and now FLX).
- Functions as a Fixed Route, but we can DEVIATE in order to pick up On-Demand Passengers (ADA, Medicaid, and now ... Public).
- No ADA required ... major cost savings.
- Can target certain areas and /or times.
- Must support/complement existing FRS.
- Must be open to general public ... not just target demographic.

SILVER LINE SPECIFICS (KILLEEN'S FLX-RT.)

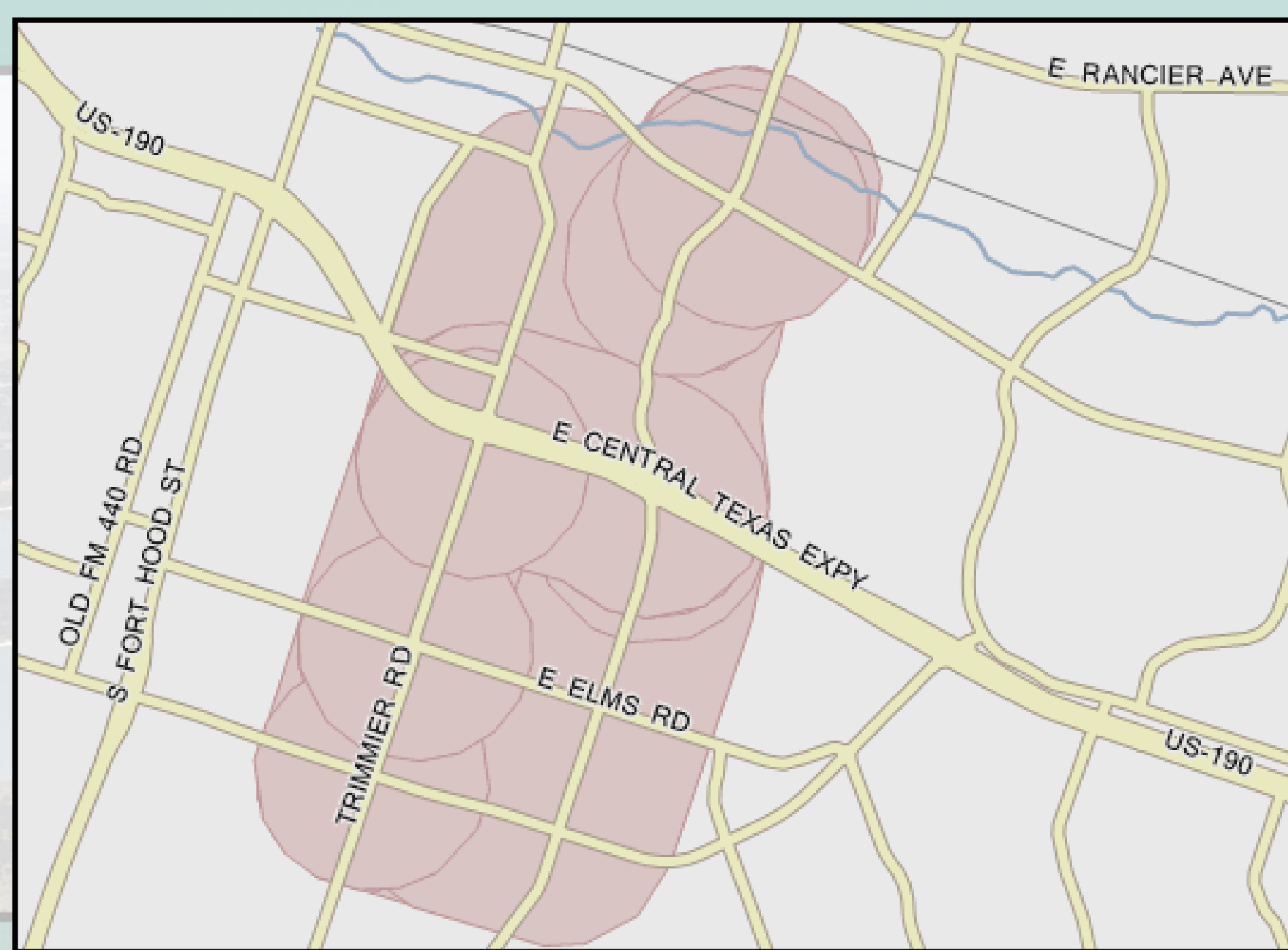
- Will operate from 8:00 am to 10:00 am and 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm.
- Services Killeen Community Center (formerly Gilmore Center), Lions Club Park, and Walmart on Lowe's Blvd. at fixed time points.
- Picks up passengers between these stops within a half-mile zone (bubble).
- Curb-to-Curb service by calling in a stop request within 48 hours in advance.
- Will operate on a 30 minute headway.
- Effective Jan. 3, 2021

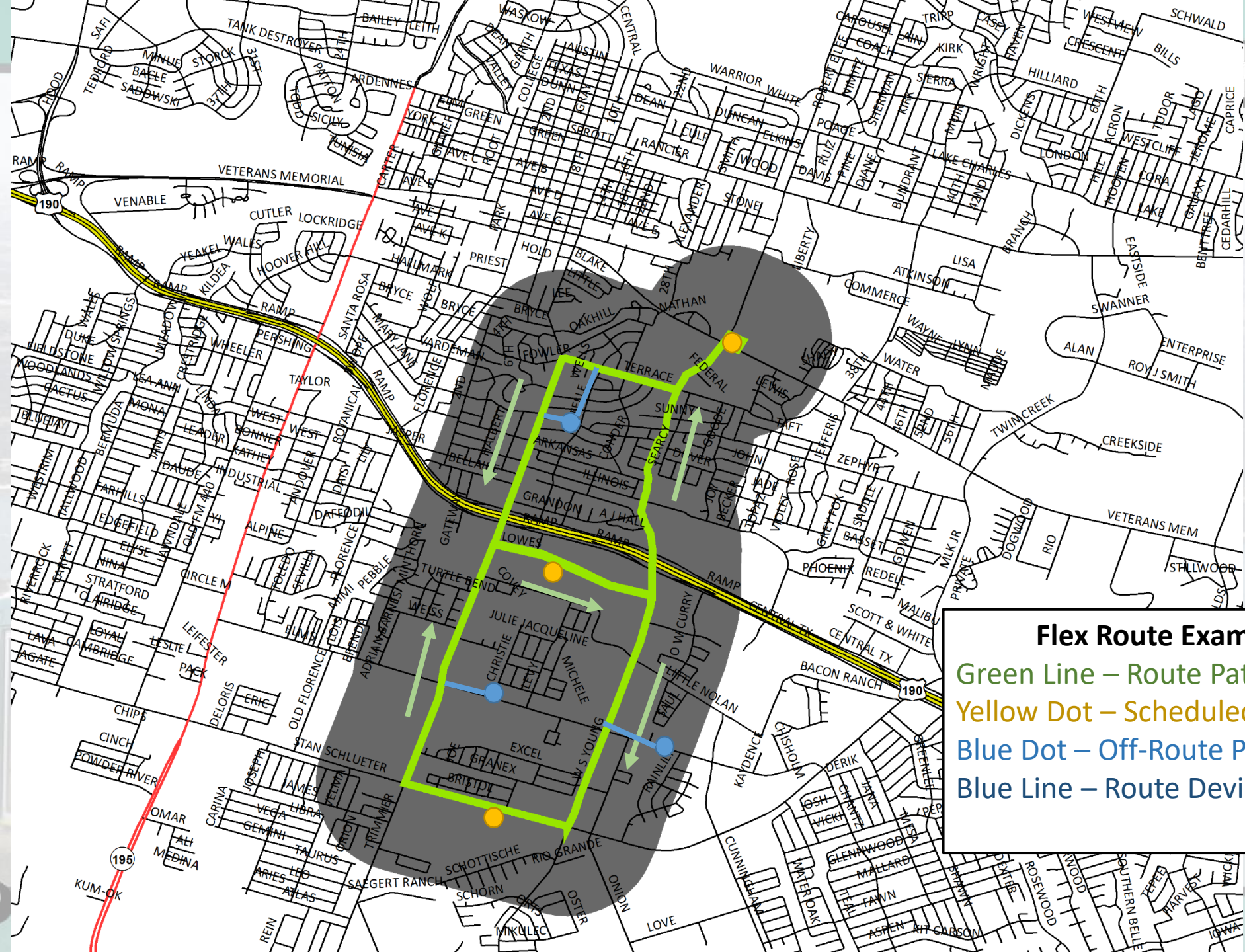


Silver Line – 9.3 Miles
